## IMPORTANT COVID-19 UPDATE – NOVEMBER 23, 2020

In response to the increase in positive COVID-19 cases in Lycoming and Clinton Counties, the Lycoming-Clinton Joinder Programs (Lycoming-Clinton Mental Health/Intellectual Disabilities/Early Intervention and HealthChoices as well as Lycoming Children and Youth Services) has re-instituted the following for the period 11/23/2020 to 12/14/2020:

- All Joinder Programs remain open for regular business hours 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM Monday thru Friday, with reduced on-site personnel. The remaining staff will be working remotely via telework.
- Access to our office facilities – The Sharwell Building in Williamsport, the 8 North Grove Street office in Lock Haven, and the Youth Campus in Montoursville – will be limited at this time. The general public is asked to make initial contacts via telephone. Emergency walk-in's will still be permitted entrance on a case-by-case basis. This is being done in an effort to maintain social distancing to mitigate the spread of the virus.
- In-person meetings with non-employees will continue on a limited basis. Meetings will continue to be held via tele-conferencing when possible.
- During regular business hours there will be staff available to answer telephones. Staff will also be scheduling in-person meetings with individuals and families on a case-by-case basis.
- All court-ordered visitations will continue to be held at this time.
- Child Abuse and Neglect Investigations and Emergency Mental Health Services including voluntary and involuntary commitment evaluations will continue as usual.
- 24-Hour Crisis Services will continue to be available as usual.
